# What We Do

- Receive mixed C&D materials
- Sort materials using manual and mechanical systems
- Process recyclables
- Manage residuals: Non-recyclable or difficult-to-sort materials are sent to landfills or transferred for further management.
- Create Commodities: Transform waste into valuables, marketable products for various industries.

# Materials We Recycle

- Concrete & Asphalt – crushed into aggregate
- Metals & Copper – Recycled into new metal products
- Wood – chipped for reuse
- Shingles, Cardboard, Tires, Mattresses, Batteries

# How Materials Are Sorted

- Manual sorting for quality control
- Mechanical systems including screens and magnets
- Maximizes recovery and minimized contamination

# Why Recycling Matters

- Reduces landfill reliance
- Conserves natural resources
- Supports Green Buildings: Helps construction projects meet sustainability goals, like LEED certification.

# 2025 Recycling Results

- 21,142 tons of **concrete**
- 6,202 tons of **metal**
- 5,342 tons of **wood**
- 2,657 tons of **shingles**
- Additional materials: **gypsum, cardboard, copper, tires, mattresses**
